## Project Work / Dissertation

UG and PG students from ShrimathiDevkunvarNanalal Bhatt Vaishnav College for Womenshall be allowed for project work /dissertation in respective areas of specialization at MarudharKesari Jain College for Women (MKJC), subject to availability of resources. The students shall work in the mutually agreeable subject areas identified by both organizations.
