# 25.Computerization of administration and the process of admission and examination results, issue of certificates:

- Administration office is equipped with computers. The data pertaining to the students are stored in the system.
- Admission process is computerized
- The college conducts regular tests and examinations. The marks reports are given to the parents during PTA meetings. Monthly attendance of the students is stored in the computer by the class teachers of the respective departments.

- Furniture worth Rs. 6,00,000 was purchased to meet the class room requirements.
- The maintenance cost of the New Building comes to Rs. 10,19,000.
