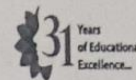

Summary




Outcome of the Programme

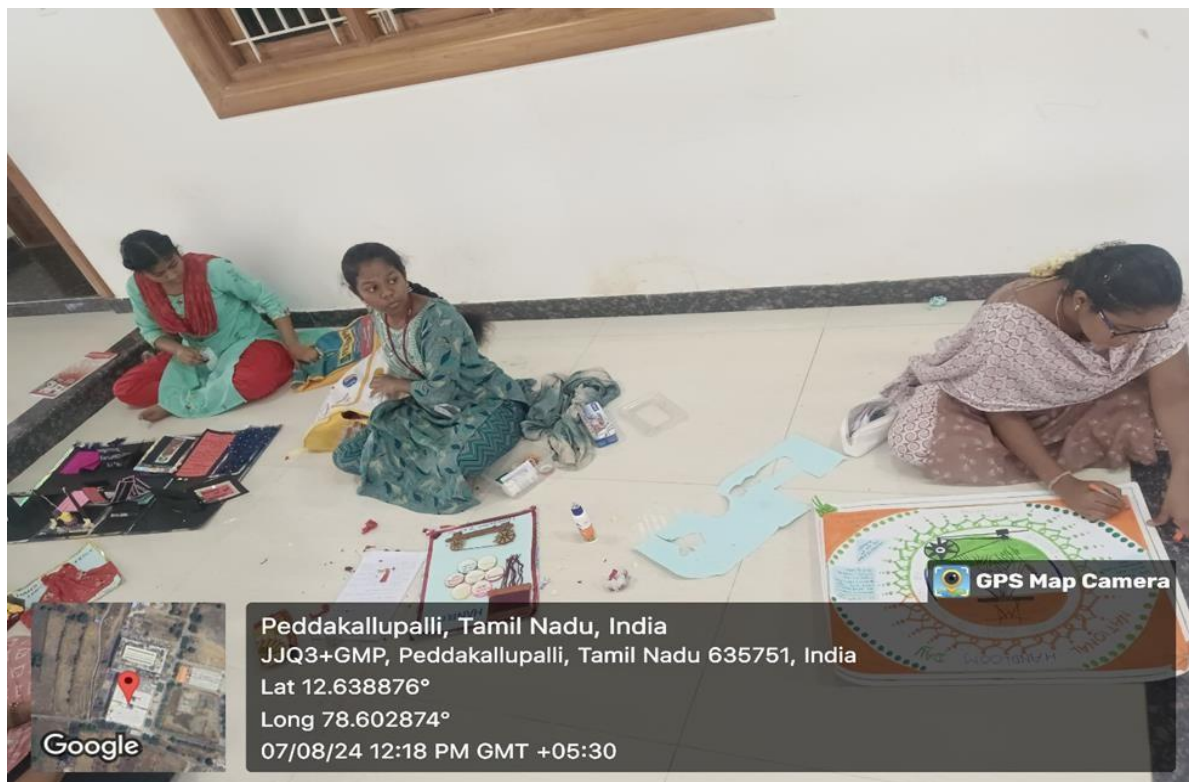
