Summary

PG & Research Department of English organized an Extension Activity titled "Equitable Access to Communication: A Program on Signature and Spoken English" on 5th February 2026 at Government Higher Secondary School, Girisamuthiram. The students of III B.A. English and II M.A. English actively participated in conducting interactive sessions for the government school students. The program was divided into two major components such as Spoken English and Grammar Session and Signature Training for Uneducated Village People.

The college students conducted engaging sessions focusing on basic grammar rules, sentence formation, everyday conversational English, vocabulary building activities and simple communication exercises. As part of promoting dignity and self-reliance, the volunteers trained uneducated villagers to write their signatures instead of affixing thumb impressions. The students were guided to educate the village people to write their names clearly, practice consistent signatures and understand the importance of signing documents.

The extension activity proved to be a meaningful and impactful initiative. By promoting spoken English skills and signature literacy, the program contributed towards social empowerment and inclusive communication. The program was successfully conducted and received positive feedback from the school students and local participants.


Outcome of the Programme

1. School students gained confidence in speaking English.
2. Participants improved their understanding of basic grammar.
3. Several villagers successfully learned to sign their names.
