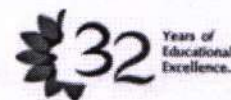

Summary Report

On the occasion of **International Women's Day**, **Marudhar Kesari Jain College for Women (Autonomous), Vaniyambadi**, signed a **Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)** with **PSV Medical Hospital, Krishnagiri**, with the objective of promoting preventive healthcare, creating continuous health awareness, and providing quality medical support to the college community through collaborative health initiatives.

To commemorate the occasion, a **General Medical Check-up Camp** was organized on **06 March 2026** at the college campus. The programme was jointly organized by the **College Union, National Service Scheme (NSS), Unnat Bharat Abhiyan**

(UBA), Youth Red Cross (YRC), and Red Ribbon Club (RRC) in collaboration with PSV Medical Hospital, Krishnagiri, and JCI, Vaniyambadi.

The medical camp benefited **212 participants**, including teaching faculty, non-teaching staff, office staff, drivers, mess staff, and carpenters. A team of qualified doctors and healthcare professionals from PSV Medical Hospital conducted comprehensive health screenings, including blood pressure monitoring, blood sugar testing, general physical examination, ear examination, women's health and hygiene consultation, and medical counseling.

The health screening facilitated the early identification of common health concerns such as blood pressure variations, blood sugar-related issues, nutritional deficiencies, ear-related complaints, headaches, and other general health conditions. Based on the medical assessment, participants received appropriate medical consultation, essential medicines, and prescriptions wherever required. Staff members requiring further evaluation were referred to **PSV Medical Hospital for Master Health Check-ups** and advanced diagnostic investigations to ensure timely diagnosis and follow-up treatment.

As part of the programme, an awareness session on "**The Power of Women**" was delivered by **Dr. S. Vivek, Managing Director, PSV Medical Hospital**, and **Dr. S. Sreeja, Obstetrician and Gynecologist, PSV Medical Hospital**. The resource persons emphasized the importance of preventive healthcare, women's health and hygiene, balanced nutrition, mental well-being, self-confidence, healthy lifestyle practices, and the importance of regular health screening for the prevention and early detection of lifestyle-related diseases.

The programme witnessed enthusiastic participation from all categories of employees and served as an effective platform for promoting preventive healthcare, creating health awareness, and strengthening institutional collaboration with healthcare organizations. The signing of the MoU established a long-term partnership to organize regular medical camps, health awareness programmes, and wellness initiatives for the benefit of the college community.

Programme Highlights

Outcomes of the Programme

1. A total of **212 employees** benefited from comprehensive medical screening and health consultation.
2. The programme enhanced awareness regarding preventive healthcare, healthy lifestyle practices, and the importance of periodic medical check-ups.
3. Early screening enabled the identification of common health concerns and facilitated timely medical intervention.
4. Essential medicines, medical counseling, and prescriptions were provided to participants based on their health assessment.
5. Beneficiaries requiring specialized care were referred to **PSV Medical Hospital** for Master Health Check-ups and advanced diagnostic evaluation.
6. The awareness session on "**The Power of Women**" strengthened participants' understanding of women's health, hygiene, nutrition, mental well-being, and preventive healthcare.
7. The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) established a sustainable partnership between the college and PSV Medical Hospital for conducting regular healthcare and wellness programmes.
8. The collaborative initiative strengthened institutional networking with healthcare organizations and promoted community engagement.
9. The programme contributed to creating a healthier and more health-conscious workplace by encouraging early diagnosis and timely medical intervention.
10. The programme supports **Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 3 – Good Health and Well-being** by promoting preventive healthcare, ensuring access to quality medical services, and fostering a culture of health and wellness within the institution.

Measurable Outcomes

- A total of **212 teaching and non-teaching staff members** underwent comprehensive health screening during the medical camp.
- **100% of the registered participants** received general medical consultation and basic health assessment.
- Health screening facilitated the early identification of common health concerns, including blood pressure variations, blood sugar-related issues, nutritional deficiencies, ear-related complaints, headaches, and other general health conditions.
- Essential medicines were distributed to participants requiring immediate medical attention, while prescriptions and follow-up recommendations were provided wherever necessary.
- Staff members requiring specialized medical care were referred to **PSV Medical Hospital** for Master Health Check-ups and advanced diagnostic investigations.
- The awareness session significantly improved participants' understanding of preventive healthcare, women's health and hygiene, nutrition, and healthy lifestyle practices.

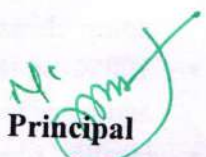
- The MoU established a structured framework for organizing regular health camps, awareness programmes, and wellness initiatives for the college community.

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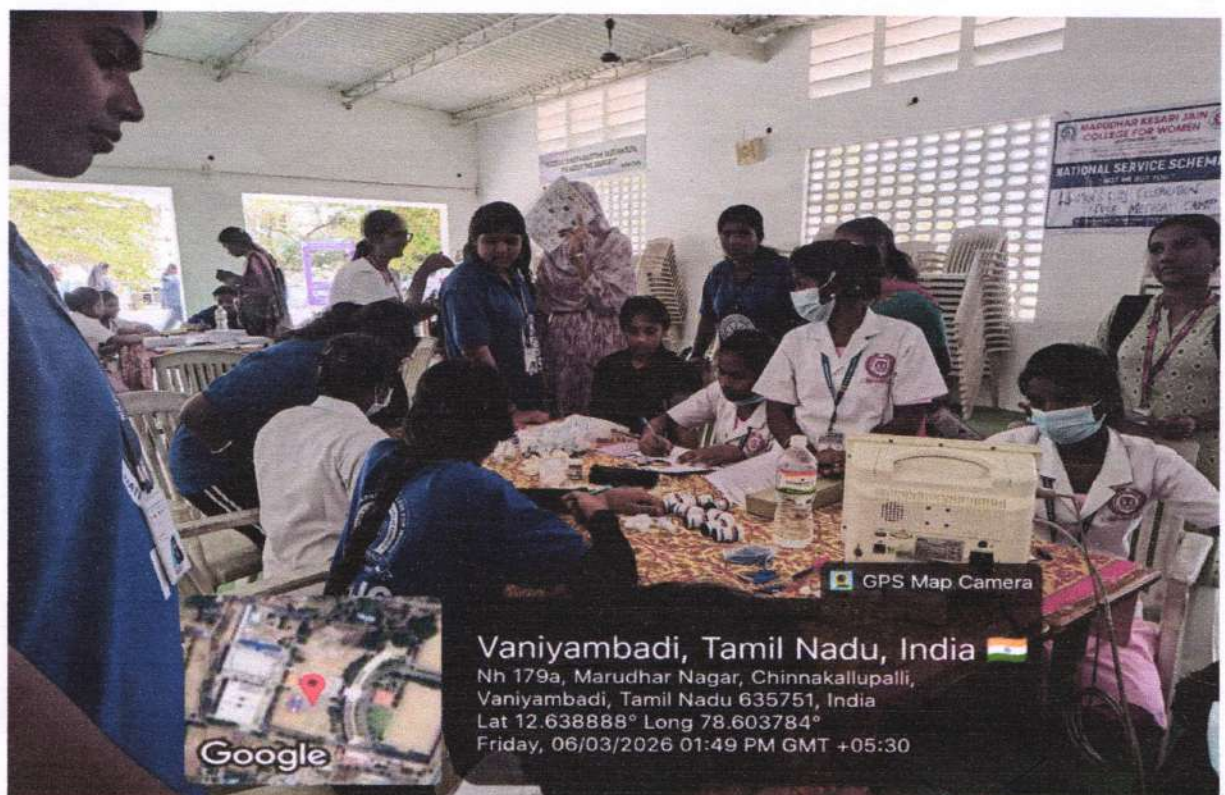
