Activity Report

Topic/ Subject of the Activity : Deworming Day

Objectives (Input)

- To create awareness among students about intestinal worm infections and their impact on health.
- To educate participants about the importance of regular deworming and preventive healthcare practices.
- To promote awareness about personal hygiene, proper handwashing, sanitation, and safe food and drinking water practices.
- To encourage students to adopt healthy habits to prevent parasitic worm infections.
- To create awareness about the importance of maintaining a healthy lifestyle for overall well-being.
- To encourage students to disseminate health and hygiene awareness among their families and communities.

Methodology(Process)

A Deworming Day Programme was organized on 19 August 2026 by the National Service Scheme (NSS), Youth Red Cross (YRC), Red Ribbon Club (RRC), Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) and Rotaract of Marudhar Kesari Jain College for Women (Autonomous), Vaniyambadi, in association with the Tamil Nadu Public Health & Preventive Medicine Department, Government of Tamil Nadu. A total of 1,379 students benefited from the awareness programme.

Output

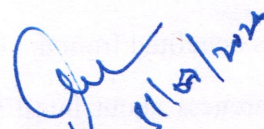
- A total of 1,379 students benefited from the Deworming Day awareness programme.
- Participants gained awareness about intestinal worm infections, their causes, prevention, and health impacts.
- Students understood the importance of regular deworming and preventive healthcare practices.
- Awareness was created regarding proper hand hygiene, sanitation, safe food, and clean drinking water.
- Participants learned the importance of maintaining personal and environmental cleanliness to prevent infections.

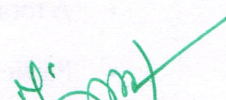
- Students were encouraged to adopt healthy hygiene practices in their daily lives.

Outcomes

- The programme directly benefited 1,379 students, strengthening their awareness of deworming, hygiene, sanitation, and preventive healthcare.
- Students developed greater awareness of intestinal worm infections and their preventive measures.
- Participants acquired knowledge about the importance of deworming and preventive healthcare.
- The programme improved awareness about personal hygiene, sanitation, safe food, and drinking water practices.
- Students understood the importance of adopting healthy habits to protect themselves from infections.
- The programme encouraged students to promote health and hygiene awareness within their families and communities.
- The programme contributed to SDG 3 – Good Health and Well-being by promoting preventive healthcare, hygiene, and healthy living practices.
- It also supports SDG 6 – Clean Water and Sanitation through awareness of sanitation, safe drinking water, and hygiene practices.

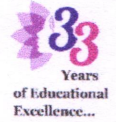
