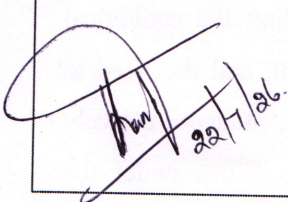
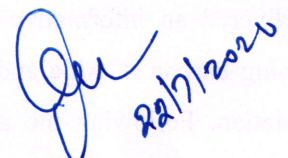
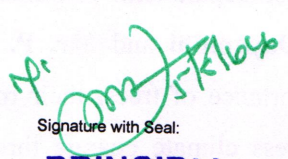
Output
