Outcome of the Program

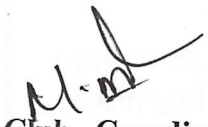
Participants became aware of the laws and punishments related to drug possession and trafficking.

Girl students developed confidence to avoid risky situations and seek help when needed.

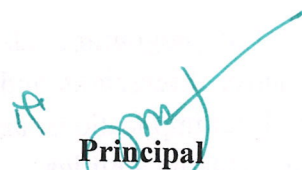
Students learned about counseling services, helplines, and trusted authorities they can approach for help.

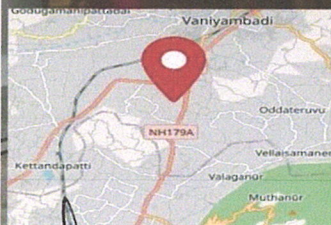
