Summary Report

The resource person proceeded about the fundamentals of fire safety, such as the fire triangle, fire classes, and fire prevention techniques. Participants learned about fire threats unique to laboratories, including electrical equipment, flammable substances, and inappropriate storage techniques. The proper use of fire extinguishers in accordance with established emergency protocols was demonstrated practically. It was also stressed how crucial it is to keep evacuation routes clean, maintain good housekeeping, and handle dangerous chemicals safely.

Outcome of the Program

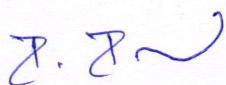

- The significance of preserving a secure laboratory environment through appropriate storage, housekeeping, and risk assessment procedures was acknowledged by the participants.

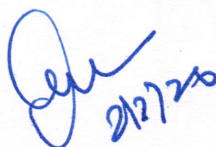

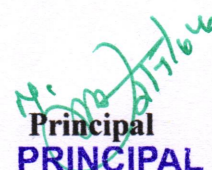

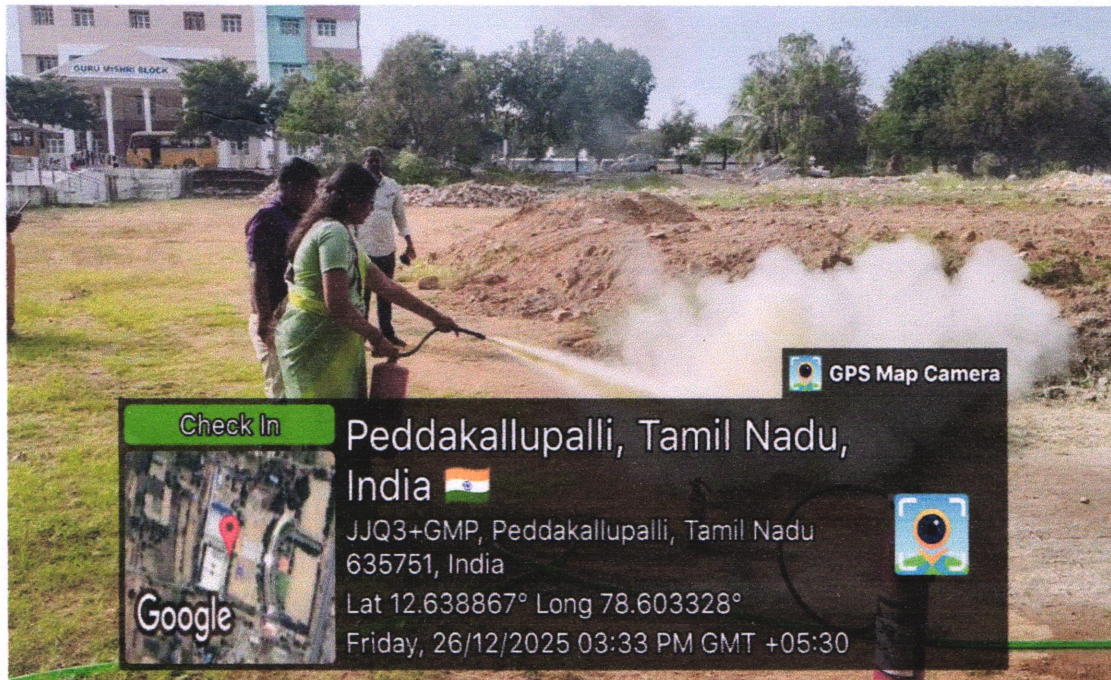
