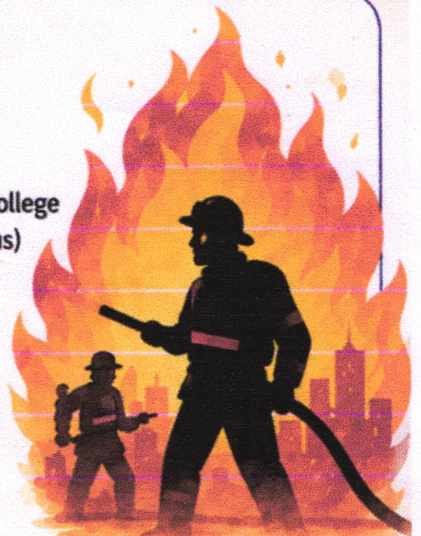

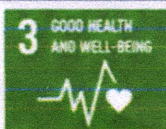

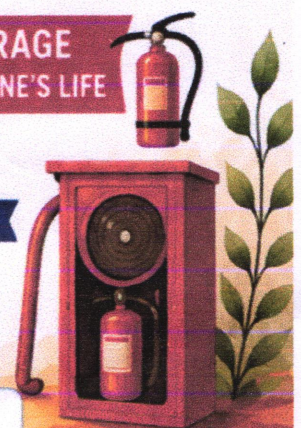

Topic / Subject of the Activity

Fire and Safety Awareness Programme

Objectives (Input)

- To create awareness among students about fire safety and emergency preparedness.
- To educate participants on the causes of fire accidents and methods of fire prevention.
- To provide knowledge about different classes of fire (Class A, B, C, and D) and the appropriate firefighting techniques.
- To familiarize students with the types and proper use of firefighting equipment.
- To develop practical skills in responding effectively during fire emergencies through live demonstrations.
- To create awareness about career opportunities in the Fire and Rescue Services.

Methodology (Process)

A Fire and Safety Awareness Programme was organized on 23 June 2026 by the National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit of Marudhar Kesari Jain College for Women (Autonomous), Vaniyambadi.

The programme was conducted by **Thiru N. Udhayaraj, Fire and Rescue Officer**, along with the Fire and Rescue Service team. The resource persons explained the causes of fire accidents, preventive measures, emergency response procedures, and essential safety precautions to be followed during fire emergencies.

The team provided detailed information on the different classes of fire (**Class A, B, C, and D**) and demonstrated the correct methods for extinguishing each type of fire. Live demonstrations were conducted on the proper use of various firefighting equipment, including **Water, Foam, Carbon Dioxide (CO₂), and Dry Chemical Powder (DCP) fire extinguishers**.

Participants were trained on emergency evacuation procedures, first-response actions during fire accidents, and the safe handling of firefighting equipment. The Fire and Rescue team also introduced the protective equipment used by firefighters, explained its importance during rescue operations, and shared information about career opportunities available in the Fire and Rescue Services.

To assess the participants' understanding, an interactive quiz on fire safety and emergency preparedness was conducted at the end of the session.

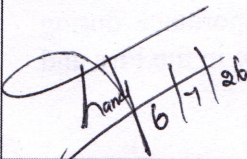
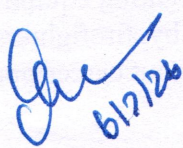
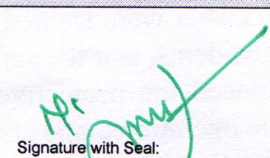
Output

- A total of **60 students** actively participated in the programme.
- Participants gained knowledge about the causes, prevention, and classification of fire hazards.
- Students learned the correct operation and application of different types of fire extinguishers through live demonstrations.

- Awareness was created regarding emergency evacuation procedures and first-response actions during fire incidents.
- Students gained information about the protective equipment used by Fire and Rescue personnel and career opportunities in the Fire and Rescue Services.
- The interactive quiz enhanced participants' understanding of fire safety concepts and emergency preparedness.

Outcomes

- Students developed greater awareness of fire hazards and preventive safety measures.
- Participants acquired practical knowledge on the appropriate use of firefighting equipment during emergency situations.
- The programme improved students' confidence in responding safely and effectively during fire accidents.
- Students understood the importance of disaster preparedness, emergency evacuation, and first-response techniques.
- The live demonstrations and interactive quiz reinforced learning and enhanced students' practical understanding of fire safety.
- The programme encouraged students to adopt safe practices and serve as responsible citizens by promoting fire safety awareness in their homes and communities.
- The programme contributed to **Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 3 – Good Health and Well-being** by promoting safety awareness and protecting human life through preventive education. It also supports **Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 11 – Sustainable Cities and Communities** by enhancing disaster preparedness, resilience, and community safety.
