

REPORT


The PG Departments of Commerce CA in association with PG and Research Department of Foods and Nutrition and Department of Tamil celebrated 4th day of Navratri golu on 18.10.2023. As Golu is the festive display of dolls and figurines in South India during the autumn festive season, particularly around the multiday, Navratri (Dussehra) festival of Hinduism, the 4th day of golu was celebrated with pomp by the faculty as well as students of the Department.

On the 4th day, Maa Kushmanda is worshipped, who is the fourth manifestation of Goddess Durga and is worshipped with utmost devotion. Maa Kushmanda's name has three words - Ku meaning little, Ushma suggesting warmth, and Anda signifying a cosmic egg.

Hindu mythology says that a flicker of Maa Kushmanda's smile created the entire universe. She is also known as Ashtabhuja Devi - as she has eight hands, she has the power and capability to live inside the Sun. The glow and radiance of her body are as luminous as that of the Sun. The Goddess provides direction and energy to the Sun. Hence, the Sun God is governed by Goddess Kushmanda.

The colour of the 4th day of Navratri golu is royal blue, which is considered good for health and wealth. On a general note, Navratri Golu brings peace and happiness among the hearts of people, and it is celebrated with hopes of more blessings from Goddess Durga.


The faculty and students worshipped Maa Kushamanda on the 4th day of Navratri golu and sought her blessings upon each and everyone. At the completion of the Pooja, sweets were distributed to all.
