



Summary

Participants

The Marudhar Kesari Jain College for Women (Autonomous) hosted the "Intra Department Competition" organized by the PG Department of Chemistry and the Mendeleev Chemistry Association. This event encompassed various categories: Paper Presentation, Poster Presentation and Model Demonstration. The competition was open to both UG and PG students of the Chemistry department.

Participants Count

A total of thirteen (13) students participated in the Oral and Poster Presentation categories, while twelve (12) students showcased their work in the Model Demonstration sections. The presentations and projects focused on Recent Trends in Chemistry.

First, second, and third prizes were awarded in each category. All the competitions were actively participated from the students in M.Sc. and B.Sc. Chemistry. Dr. C. Asokan served as the judge for the Oral Presentation. First and Second places were awarded to third-year

B.Sc students, and Third place was awarded to a First-year M.Sc student. Ms. R. Mahalakshmi served as the judge for the Poster Presentation. First and Second places were awarded to Third-year B.Sc students, followed by two First-year B.Sc students who shared the Third prize. Dr. K. Prabu served as the judge for the Model Demonstration. First place was awarded to a Second-year M.Sc team, Second place to a Second-year B.Sc team, and Third place was shared by two Second-year B.Sc teams.

The overall event was marked by enthusiastic and confident participation from the students.
