Summary

The Nature Science Foundation (NSF), a nationally accredited inspection body under the Ministry of Commerce & Industry, conducted a comprehensive sustainability audit at Marudhar Kesari Jain College for Women, Chinnakalupalli, Vaniyambadi, Tamil Nadu. The audit was carried out in alignment with National Building Code of India, Part 11 (Approach to Sustainability), focusing on the institution's commitment to ecofriendly and sustainable practices.

The inspection took place on 28th June 2025, and the certificate was issued on 9th July 2025, valid until 27th June 2027. The inspection covered seven critical environmental and sustainability domains that are essential for creating a green and responsible educational environment.

1. Green Audit:

The Green Audit assessed the use and conservation of natural resources such as plants, water, and land within the campus. The college demonstrated green campus initiatives including plantation drives, maintenance of garden spaces, and eco-restoration practices that

reduce carbon footprint and enhance campus biodiversity.

2. Environment Audit:

The Environment Audit examined policies, activities, and infrastructure in relation to environmental protection. This included assessing pollution control measures, environmental policy awareness, and efforts made to align college operations with environmental regulations.

3. Energy Audit:

This audit evaluated energy usage patterns and conservation strategies. The college showed responsible energy management by utilizing energy-efficient appliances, encouraging the use of natural lighting and ventilation, and taking steps towards adopting renewable energy sources such as solar panels.

4. Waste Management Audit:

The waste audit focused on the college's strategies for segregation, recycling, and disposal of solid and liquid waste. The institution was found to practice scientific waste disposal methods, promote zero-waste activities, and spread awareness on reducing plastic usage.

5. Soil and Water Audit:

This segment assessed soil preservation and water resource management. Rainwater harvesting structures, regular soil testing, efficient irrigation methods, and water conservation techniques were observed to be in place, ensuring minimal wastage and sustainable usage of water resources.

6. Air Quality Audit:

Air quality on campus was evaluated to ensure a healthy atmosphere for students and staff. The audit found low pollution levels due to the presence of green belts, reduced vehicle usage inside campus, and promotion of pollution-free practices.

7. Hygiene Audit:

Hygiene practices, including sanitation facilities, drinking water quality, and overall cleanliness of the campus were assessed. The college maintained high hygiene standards with clean restrooms, proper waste bins, and frequent cleaning schedules to promote health and well-being.


Conclusion:

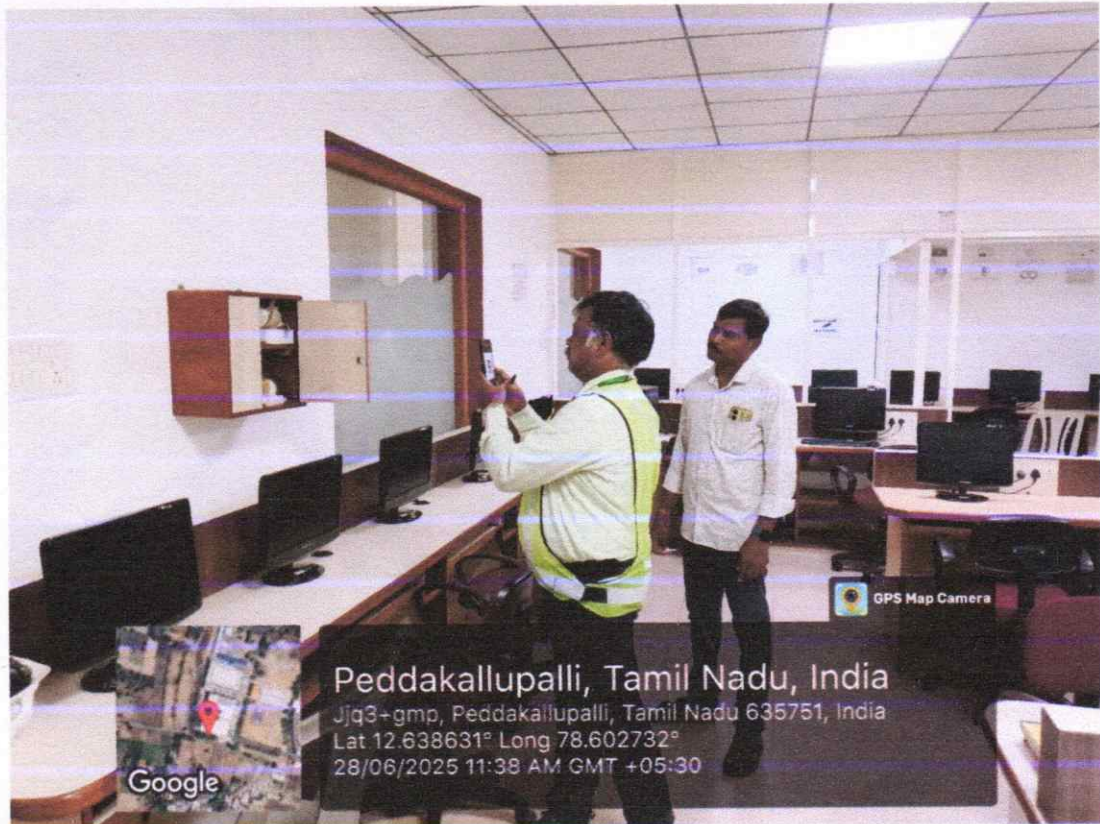


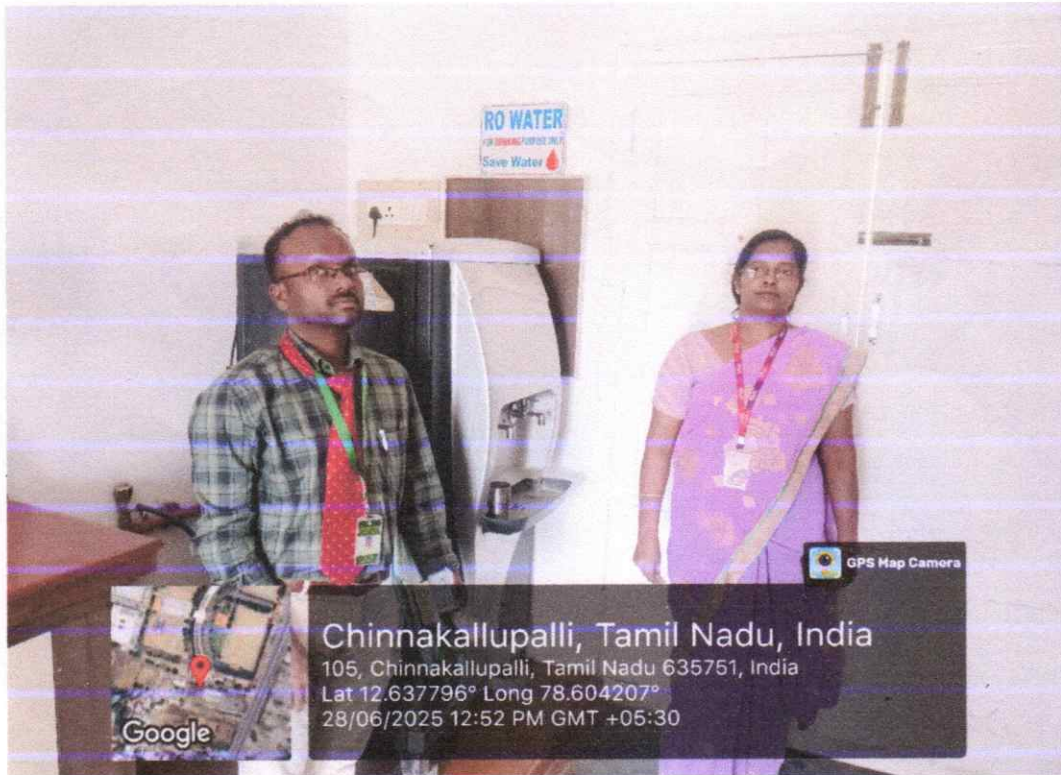
