Objectives

The objective of the programme was to create awareness about the importance of water conservation and the need to prevent water wastage. It aimed to educate the public on sustainable water management, improve groundwater resources, and promote access to clean water and sanitation.

Summary Report

The "World Water Day" was celebrated on 23 March 2026 at at Adiyur Village. The programme was jointly organized by the Go Green Association and the National Service Scheme (NSS) in collaboration with Vergal Foundation. The event was presided over by the College President Mr. V. Dilip Kumar Jain and the Secretary Mr. Anand Singvi. The programme was inaugurated by the Principal, Dr. M. Inbavalli, who delivered the felicitation address. The special guests included Mr. Vadivel Subramaniam, President of Vergal Foundation, and Mr. Radhakrishnan, President of Adiyur Farmers Welfare Association. In his address, Mr. Vadivel Subramaniam emphasized that water is a precious gift of nature and highlighted the responsibility of conserving it for future generations. He spoke about preventing water wastage, improving groundwater levels, strengthening water resource management, promoting awareness among the public, ensuring

access to clean water, and providing proper sanitation facilities for all. The students took a pledge with the slogan "Save every drop, protect a prosperous and sustainable society," and conducted an awareness rally from Adiyur towards the Dharmapuri road in Tirupattur, spreading awareness among the public. Furthermore, the students undertook desilting and restoration work of a 75-acre lake in Adiyur using machinery provided by Exnora. More than 100 students participated in the programme along with Kalam Foundation volunteer Raja T.K. Murugan, Tirupattur Municipal Council Member Sudhakar, Exnora Coordinator Giridharan, Adiyur Panchayat President Anandakumar, Vice President Palani, and members Sathyamoorthy, Ramkumar, Kali, Dhananjeyan, Perumal, Moorthy, and the general public. The programme was successfully organized by the NSS Coordinator Prof. S. Aruna and the Go Green Association Coordinator Prof. N. Vijayalakshmi.
