

#### **Summary**

The Art of Saying No' on 23.12.2024 at Roop Rajat Block AV Hall hall at around 10.00 a.m. The program began with the prayer song followed by invocation to Mother Tamil. Ms. Swetha S, the alumnae resource person gave us many insights on what is criticism, its positive approaches and negative approaches. She shared a point on whether criticism is good or bad that made the students think about it. The students gained knowledge on the types of criticism in which the positive criticism looks different that made them to think in other perspective. The examples given were really good that related counselling a criticized client. She helped the students to understand that they have to accept the criticism because sometimes it gives them a positive result. She also shared the importance of setting boundaries.

She conducted an activity, where the students were divided into two groups, one was the advertiser's team and the other team was meant to criticize the advertisement done. She motivated the students to follow assertive technique for handling criticism. She also conducted an activity whereby the participants were asked to recollect their traumatic experience and write it in a paper, which helped the students to get rid of their negative emotion and come out of traumatic experiences. She also suggested some movies and books like Inside out, Freedom Writers, Nanban, The art of saying No, Don't say yes when you want to say 'No' and I am ok, you're ok.

The students then shared their valuable feedbacks regarding the seminar. Vote of thanks was proposed by Ms. Sidra Kulsum K P of I B.Sc Psychology and the program came to an end by singing the National Anthem.
