MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (herein after referred to as the “MoU”) is entered into on this 17th July 2026 (17.07.2026) by and between:

The School of Life Sciences (Department of Biotechnology, Biochemistry, Microbiology & Foods and Nutrition), Marudhar Kesari Jain College for Women (Autonomous), located at Chinnakallupalli, Vaniyambadi, Tirupattur District, Tamil Nadu, India – 635751, represented herein by its Principal/Dean, herein after referred to as the “**First Party**”, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context, include its successors, administrators, and assigns.

AND

Natureza Pharma Products Pvt Ltd, having its research laboratory located at Kalappanahalli Road, Matlampatti, Dharmapuri 635205, Tamil Nadu, India, represented herein by its Managing Director, hereinafter referred to as the “**Second Party**”, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context, include its successors, administrators and assigns.

(The First Party and Second Party are hereinafter collectively referred to as the “Parties” and individually as a “Party”)

WHEREAS

- A. The First Party is a Higher Educational Institution, namely:
The School of Life Sciences (Department of Biotechnology, Biochemistry, Microbiology & Foods and Nutrition), Marudhar Kesari Jain College for Women (Autonomous), Vaniyambadi – 635751.
- B. Both Parties believe that collaboration and cooperation between them will promote effective utilization of resources and provide enhanced opportunities for students and faculty.
- C. The Parties intend to cooperate in the areas of Skill Development, Education, Research, Internship Training, Academic Projects, and Placement Guidance.
- D. Both Parties, being legal entities, desire to enter into this MoU to advance their mutual interests.
- E. Natureza Pharma Products Pvt Ltd is engaged in Research, Skill Development, Industry-Oriented Training, Employability Skills Development, Academic Project Guidance and Placement Assistance.
- F. Both Parties recognize the mutual benefits of academic–industry collaboration and seek to strengthen knowledge exchange and professional development opportunities.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MoU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1

CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties shall establish channels of communication and cooperation that will promote and advance their respective objectives. They shall keep each other informed of opportunities relevant to their mutual interests.
- 1.2 The cooperation between the Parties shall facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of faculty members and industry experts in developing suitable teaching and training systems that meet current industry requirements.
- 1.3 The general terms of cooperation shall be governed by this MoU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and may enter into additional agreements, deeds, or documents as required to implement the objectives of this MoU. Such documents shall form part of the overall understanding between the Parties.

CLAUSE 2

SCOPE OF THE MoU

2.1 The students of the **First Party** shall benefit from academic and industrial collaboration aimed at enhancing their technical knowledge, practical skills, innovation, and employability.

2.2	Skill	Development	Programmes:
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The Second Party shall provide training on biochemical instruments, laboratory techniques, academic project methodologies, research practices, and soft skills to bridge the gap between academia and industry.

2.3 Internship, Academic Projects and Placement Assistance:

The Second Party shall facilitate internship opportunities, academic project guidance, and placement assistance for deserving students of the First Party.

2.4 Both Parties shall obtain all necessary approvals, permissions, and licenses required for implementing activities under this MoU.

2.5 Participation in internships and academic projects at the Second Party's laboratory shall be voluntary and based on the willingness of individual students.

2.6 There shall be no financial commitment on the part of the First Party for any programme under this MoU. Any financial arrangements, if required, shall be mutually agreed upon separately in writing.

2.7 **Product** **Development:**

The Parties agree to collaborate in the development, formulation, standardization and commercialization of herbal and pharmaceutical products. Products developed under this collaboration shall be based primarily on the biological resources, medicinal plant materials, research outputs and technical resources generated or available through the School of Life Sciences **First Party**, with due acknowledgment of the contributions of both Parties and subject to applicable regulatory requirements.

CLAUSE 3

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

3.1 Intellectual Property includes copyrights, trademarks, patents, utility models, trade secrets, research methodologies, systems, processes, procedures and any other intellectual property rights recognized under applicable laws.

3.2 The First Party shall not disclose, utilize, reproduce or commercialize any confidential information belonging to the Second Party during the validity of this MoU and for a period of five (5) years after its termination.

3.3 The First Party shall not use any intellectual property based on the systems, processes, protocols, methodologies or models of the Second Party without prior written permission.

3.4 Student project work and collaborative activities carried out under this MoU may be recorded and acknowledged in academic records, subject to applicable institutional regulations.

3.5 Both Parties acknowledge that the obligations relating to confidentiality and intellectual property shall remain effective during the validity period of this MoU.

3.6 Both Parties agree that these provisions are essential conditions for entering into this MoU.

CLAUSE 4

VALIDITY

4.1 This MoU shall remain in force for a period of **Five (5) Years** commencing from 16th June 2026 and may be extended by mutual written consent of both Parties.

4.2 Either Party may terminate this MoU by providing **30 days' written notice** to the other Party. Upon termination, both Parties shall fulfill any obligations already undertaken prior to such termination.

CLAUSE 5

RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

5.1 The Parties agree that they are acting as independent entities under this MoU. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as creating a partnership, joint venture, agency relationship, or employer–employee relationship. Neither Party shall use the name, logo, or reputation of the other Party without prior written consent. Neither Party shall have authority to bind the other Party to any obligation, agreement, or liability without prior written authorization.

First Party

Second Party

Any dispute arising out of or relating to the interpretation or implementation of this MoU shall be resolved amicably through mutual consultation. Failing such resolution, the dispute shall be referred to arbitration in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

The venue of arbitration shall be the District Headquarters of the First Party, and the proceedings shall be governed by the laws of India. Courts having jurisdiction over the First Party shall have exclusive jurisdiction in matters arising under this MoU.
