


- Crafting compelling introductions and conclusions.

Finally the session was ended with vote of thanks which was given by Ms. M.Arptha Maloji Bharate I BSc AI

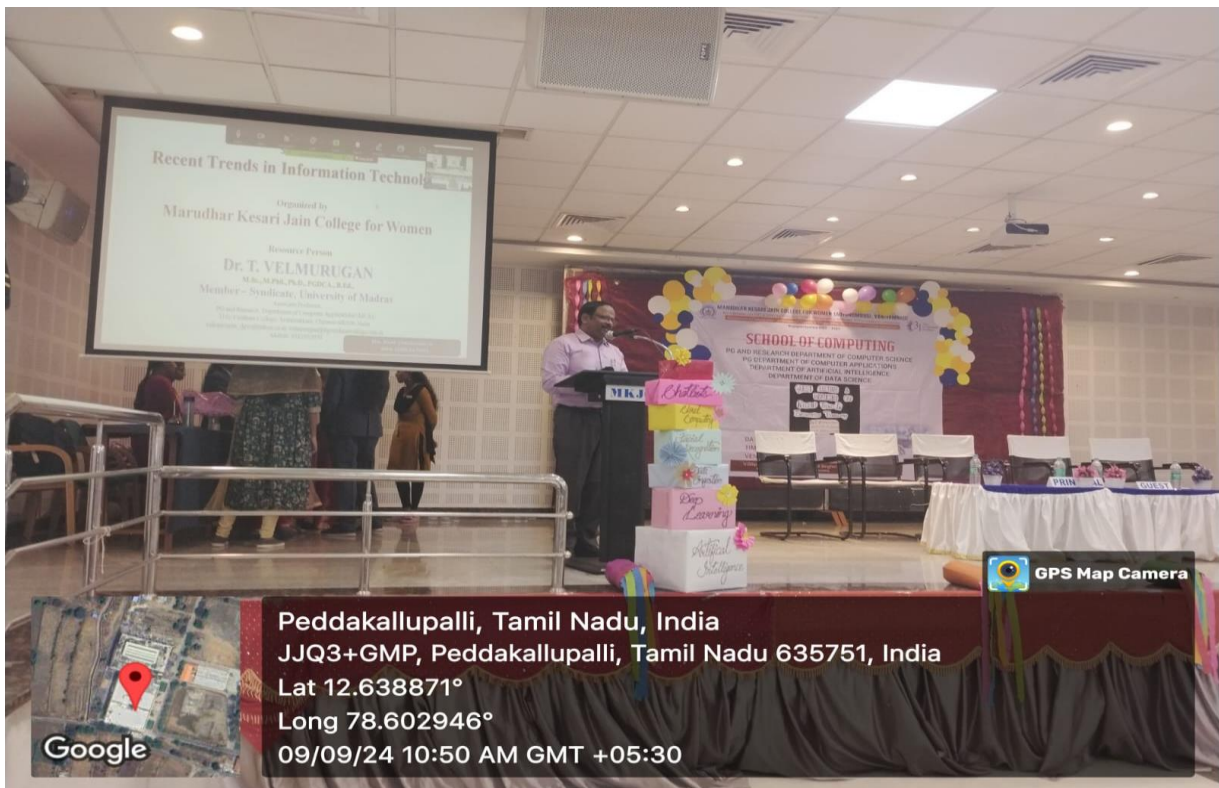
Outcome of the Programme
