Topic : National Reading Day

Objectives (Input)

Mthodology (Process)

The MKJC Library and Readers Club jointly organized National Reading Day on 19 June 2026 at 9.30 a.m. in the Sri Roop Rajat Seminar Hall. The programme commenced with Tamil Thai Vazhthu, followed by the Welcome Address. The Principal, Dr. M. Inbavalli, felicitated the gathering. Mr. K. Navukkarasan, Assistant Professor, Department of Tamil, Marudhar Kesari Jain College for Women (Autonomous), Vaniyambadi, delivered the Special Address. A Book Reading Pledge was also administered to all the participants. During his address, the speaker explained that reading transforms a person in the same way a sculptor creates a beautiful sculpture by removing unnecessary parts. He highlighted the life and contributions of P.N. Panicker, who founded a library at the age of seventeen and initiated the Library Movement in Kerala. He also explained that June 19 is observed as National Reading Day in memory of P.N. Panicker to promote the culture of reading among people.

The resource person encouraged students to cultivate the habit of reading every day. He advised them to read books related to their field of study, biographies of successful personalities, and self-improvement books. He explained that regular reading enhances knowledge, improves vocabulary and language skills, reduces spelling mistakes, develops self-confidence, and broadens one's thinking. He also shared inspiring quotations emphasizing that reading today helps students achieve success and lead a better future.

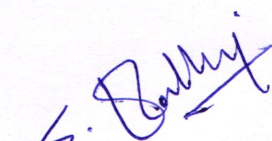
The programme concluded with the Vote of Thanks and the National Anthem. Students actively participated in the programme and were motivated to develop a lifelong reading habit.

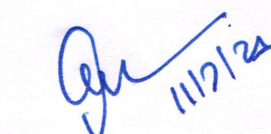
Output

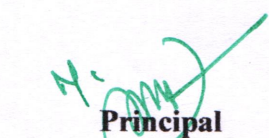
- A total of 410 UG students participated in the National Reading Day programme.
