Methodology (Process)

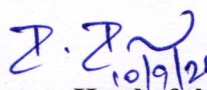

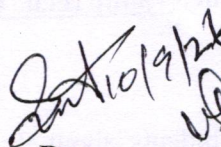
Output

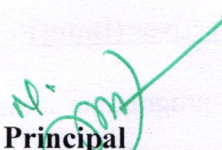

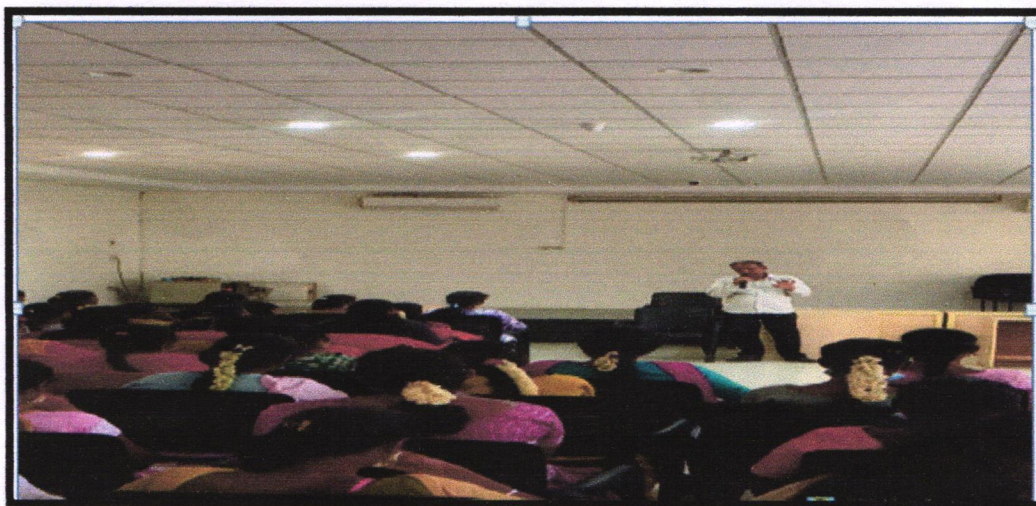
