Summary

The PG Department of Psychology under the School of Life Sciences of Marudhar Kesari Jain College for Women (Autonomous), conducted Webinar on 'Mental Health - A Universal Human Right' on 27.01.2025 at Roop Rajat block AV hall through Zoom platform, between 11.00 a.m - 12.30 p.m. The program began with a prayer song followed by invocation to Mother Tamil.

Ms. Srimathi M of II B.Sc Psychology welcomed the gathering by proposing the welxome address. The Dean, School of Lifesciences, Dr.C.Asokan felicitated the gathering by highlighting the importance of mental health in our lives. Ms. Manisha Devi B A of II B.Sc Psychology introduced the resource person for the webinar. The session was then handed over to Ms. Arthy Sriram, Counselling Psychologist, Ex - Treasurer, Chennai Counselors Foundation, Treasurer, Indian Academy of Professional Supervisors, Chennai.

Ms. Arthy Sriram begun by defining the mental health, mental illness, human rights and explained why mental health is important and the various factors that contribute to mental health problems like biological factors, life experiences, family history etc. She also spoke on the challenges related to mental health like lack of awareness, financial resources, stigma, rise in severity etc.

The resource person also hightlighted the various provisions and articles which highlighted the importance of mental health like National Mental Health Programme, Mental Healthcare Act, 2017, Kiran helpline, National Tele Mental Health Programme. She also insisted the students to prioritize their self care, to cultivate resilience by practicing gratitude, cultivating a positive mindset and by seeking professional help. The resource person then explained about the various ways and steps to improve one's mental health and the need for mental health in current scenario.

The students found the webinar to be very thought provoking, as they interacted with the resource person and got their queries cleared. They also registered their valuable feedbacks about the session. Ms. Avina Shree A P of I B.Sc Psychology then proposed the vote of thanks. The session came to an end by singing the National Anthem.


