SUMMARY REPORT

TOPIC / SUBJECT OF THE ACTIVITY

The Ivan Pavlov Association of the PG Department of Psychology under the School of Life Sciences, Mental Health and Well - Being Cell of Marudhar Kesari Jain College for Women (Autonomous), Vaniyambadi in association with District Legal Services Authority, Tirupattur, organized an Awareness Programme titled 'Trapped Behind the Scam' on account of World Day against trafficking in Persons on 29.07.2026 at Sri Roop Rajat Seminar Hall.

The awareness programme aimed to sensitise students to the psychological, social and legal dimensions of trafficking and scams and to equip them with the knowledge required to identify warning signs and respond safely.

PROGRAMME PROCEEDINGS

The programme commenced with Prayer and Tamil Thaaai Vazhthu, creating a solemn and purposeful beginning to the event. The Welcome Address was delivered by Ms. Iqra Tharannum, II B.Sc. Psychology, MKJC, who extended a warm welcome to the dignitaries, resource persons, faculty members and participants. The felicitation was rendered by Dr. M. Inbavalli, Principal, MKJC, acknowledging the presence and valuable contribution of the distinguished guests and resource persons towards their role in combatting various social issues related to human trafficking. This was followed by the Introduction of the Resource Persons, presented by Ms. Musfira Naaz H B, III B.Sc. Psychology, MKJC. The resource persons were then formally honoured by the dignitaries on the dais.

OBJECTIVES (INPUT):

- To create awareness among students about human trafficking and its various forms.
- To sensitise students to the risks associated with scams, deception and exploitation.
- To help participants recognise the warning signs and vulnerabilities associated with trafficking and fraudulent activities.
- To provide students with awareness of legal rights, remedies and support mechanisms.
- To familiarise participants with appropriate ways of responding to and reporting suspected cases.

METHODOLOGY (PROCESS):

The programme adopted a multimodal and participatory awareness methodology, combining expert interaction, legal awareness, student participation and creative communication.

1. Expert-Based Awareness Session

The programme featured legal experts from the **District Legal Services Authority, Tirupattur**. The resource persons were:

- **Tmt. J. Nagalakshmi @ Vijayarani, B.A., B.L., Senior Civil Judge & Secretary, DLSA, Tirupattur**, who spoke on the role and functions of One Stop Crisis Team and District Legal Services Authority, Tirupattur in fighting against human trafficking and its various consequences.
- **Thiru. Thanigasalam, Revenue Divisional Officer, Vaniyambadi** who highlighted the role of Government of Tamil Nadu in ending slave trade
- **Adv. Roseann Rajan, Advocate, Madras High Court and Legal Consultant, Adhiboomi**, who addressed the gathering on the key features and legal provisions of laws against human trafficking.

The expert session enabled participants to gain insights into trafficking, scams and related legal concerns from professionals with relevant legal experience.

2. Oath Taking

An **oath-taking activity** was conducted with the participants. This served as a participatory component of the programme and reinforced the commitment of students towards awareness, vigilance and responsible action.

3. Student-Centred Creative Activities

The programme incorporated creative methods to communicate the seriousness of human trafficking.

A **skit on Human Trafficking** was presented by the students of Psychology. The activity provided a realistic and engaging representation of the issue and helped communicate awareness messages in an accessible manner.

A **Fashion Walk on Human Trafficking** was also presented by the Psychology students. The activity used visual and creative expression to reinforce the central message of the programme.

4. Participant Feedback

Feedback was obtained from the participants following the programme. The feedback mechanism was used to understand participants' perceptions of the relevance and effectiveness of the programme and to identify areas for improvement in future awareness initiatives.

OUTPUT:

The immediate outputs of the awareness programme included:

- Conduct of a structured awareness programme on human trafficking and scams.
- Participation of students in an expert-led awareness session.
- Interaction with legal professionals from DLSA, Tirupattur.
- Conduct of an oath-taking activity.
- Presentation of a student skit on human trafficking.
- Presentation of a fashion walk on human trafficking.
- Collection of participant feedback.
- Creation of a platform for integrating psychological awareness, legal knowledge and creative communication.

OUTCOMES:

The programme contributed to the following outcomes:

1. Increased Awareness

Participants gained greater awareness of the seriousness of human trafficking and the different ways in which individuals may become vulnerable to exploitation and scams.

2. Legal Awareness

The interaction with legal professionals provided participants with exposure to legal perspectives concerning trafficking, exploitation and appropriate action.

3. Improved Vigilance

The programme encouraged students to remain alert to suspicious situations and recognise potential indicators of trafficking and scams.

4. Psychological Sensitisation

As the programme was organised by the Department of Psychology, it created an opportunity to understand trafficking not merely as a legal or social issue but also as a phenomenon involving **psychological vulnerability, manipulation, coercion and exploitation.**

5. Development of Social Responsibility

The oath-taking component encouraged students to view prevention and awareness as a shared social responsibility.

6. Enhanced Student Engagement

The skit and fashion walk enabled students to become active contributors rather than passive recipients of information. These activities provided opportunities for students to communicate awareness messages creatively.

7. Strengthened Institutional Collaboration

The collaboration between the **PG Department of Psychology, Mental Health and Well-Being Cell and District Legal Services Authority, Tirupattur** demonstrated an interdisciplinary approach to addressing an important social issue.

Overall Impact

The awareness programme **“Trapped Behind the Scam”** provided a comprehensive platform for addressing human trafficking through **legal awareness, psychological sensitisation**

and creative student participation. The involvement of legal professionals strengthened the practical dimension of the programme, while the student-led skit and fashion walk made the awareness campaign engaging and relatable.

The programme successfully created an environment in which students could understand the importance of vigilance, awareness, prevention and responsible action against trafficking and exploitation. It also highlighted the importance of collaboration between educational institutions and legal-service organisations in addressing socially relevant issues.

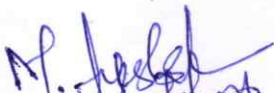
CONCLUSION

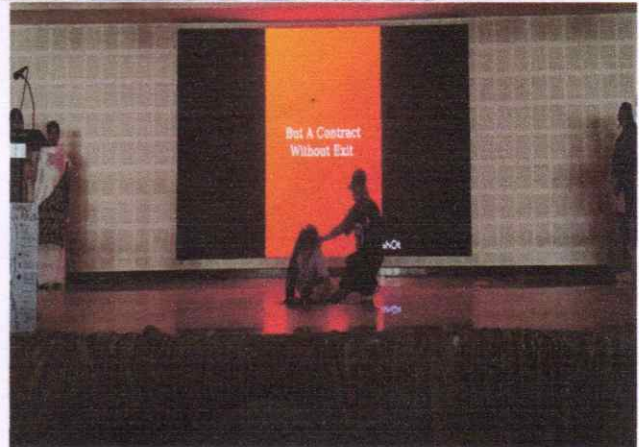
